

## **Information Regarding the Upcoming 5th Grade Band Concert**

Dear Band Parents,

**On Friday, February 7, all band students from our district will participate in WASBF, Waterford Area Schools Band Festival, at Waterford Union High School. Registration forms indicating students' names, instrument and t-shirt size will be completed during band class. Those forms as well as the Italian Dinner paperwork will be available for you on the band website. Please read the following below. Thank you!**

- At 1:45 p.m. Woodfield and Trailside Band Students will be bussed to Waterford Union High School. Evergreen Band will walk to the high school at 1:45 but will be bussed in case of bad weather. FRMS students will walk to the high school at 12:15.
- Students will remain at the high school for elementary / middle school/ and mass band rehearsals, a WHS jazz band performance, and a snack provided by the WHS boosters. All students will participate in a 6:00 p.m. concert. The concert will last about 40 minutes. All students will be dismissed and are free to leave with their parents as soon as instruments, stands and chairs are put away.
- Again, the evening performance begins at 6:00 p.m. at Waterford Union High School Gymnasium. It is open to the public.

### **The concert attire for the day:**

- Appropriate school clothes. All students will receive a special WASBF t-shirt to wear for the concert. Please do not wear jeans with holes or sloppy sweatpants. Students need to dress warm for traveling. Hats, gloves, coats, backpacks, etc. will be stored at the high school. Be sure to pick up everything before leaving WHS.

### **On the day of the concert, Friday, February 7, students should remember:**

- To bring their instruments and music to their elementary school in the morning.
- Water bottles are encouraged.

*We ask that parents please help to remind their children to bring their instrument to school on the morning of February 7. This will be the only full rehearsal the students will have for this concert.*

### **A detailed itinerary will be sent home soon.**

Since all the band students will be going to the high school the day of the concert, a permission slip is required. Students already returned that slip in September. Please keep this letter for future reference. If you have any questions, you may contact me at:
